

**VILLAGE OF McDONALD, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE NO. 509.11 REGARDING USE OF VILLAGE PARKS.

WHEREAS, due to recent activity in the Village parks, Council deems it prudent to amend Codified Ordinance 509.11 regarding the Use of Village Parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF McDONALD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO that:

Clause I. Codified Ordinance 509.11, entitled Use of Village Parks, which presently reads as follows:

- (a) Council has determined that McDonald residents and McDonald Local School District residents shall be given priority in the use of the basketball and tennis courts.
 - (1) McDonald residents and McDonald Local School District residents shall be given priority in the use of the parks, basketball and tennis courts, and that in some instances, restrictions shall be placed on the use of the parks and facilities where unrestricted use of such facilities would result in exclusion of residents.
 - (2) Any person found violating any provision of this section may either be arrested or ejected from the Park and/or have their park privileges suspended for a period to be determined by the Park Supervisor, Park Attendant, Village Administrator or Law Enforcement Officer.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) Council has determined that Village residents and McDonald Local School District students shall be given priority in the use of the basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and other Village park facilities.
 - (1) To provide Village residents and McDonald Local School District students priority use of the basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and other Village park facilities, the Mayor and/or Village Administrator are authorized to place rules and restrictions on the use of the Village park facilities where unrestricted use may result in the exclusion of, or limitation of use by, Village residents or McDonald Local School District students.

(2) The Mayor and/or the Village Administrator are authorized to set and regulate the days and hours during which the basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and/or other Village park facilities are open for use.

(b) Whoever violates any provision of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. In addition, any person violating any provision of this section may be removed from the Village parks and/or have their park privileges suspended for a period to be determined by the Park Supervisor, Park Attendant, Village Administrator or Law Enforcement Officer.

Clause II. Any and all other Ordinances, Resolutions, sections, or parts thereof inconsistent or in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, rescinded, and held for naught.

Clause III. The passage of this Ordinance and all deliberations relating to the passage of this Ordinance were held in open meetings in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22

Clause IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
